2025 CONFERENCE RECAP



On behalf of Galveston College and the Texas Gulf Coast Community College Consortium, thank you for supporting the 2025 Women in Industry Conference on April 1. With over 1,200 attendees, this was the most successful event to date.

Six hundred ninety-two high school students from 26 schools across 15 districts, including Alief, Alvin, Brazosport, Galveston, and more, participated. Additionally, 131 college students from institutions like Alvin, Brazosport, Galveston, Lee, San Jacinto, and Wharton County Junior College attended, along with 142 women exploring new career opportunities.

We're grateful to our keynote speakers, Janis Lucas (ExxonMobil) and Amanda Knost (Worley), as well as the 20 other speakers and panelists, who served as inspiring role models.
